

GET OUT THE FLOAT

PARENTAL PERMISSION AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

Please read the following agreement carefully, by signing this release form you are asserting that you are the parent or legal guardian of the undersigned minor, and that you agree to the terms and conditions of this form, the Code of Conduct, and Terms of Service on behalf of the minor attending Get Out the Float. If you have any questions, please contact us at registration@getoutthefloat.com and we will do our best to assist you.

This form must be submitted upon registration at Get Out the Float before the minor may pick up their badge. The form may be signed in person during badge pickup, or it may be notarized and digitally sent to our email at: registration@getoutthefloat.com

If you are the Parent or Legal Guardian of multiple minors who are attending Get Out the Float, you will be required to fill out a release form for each child attending our event.

Age Requirements

- Minors under the Age of 16 attending Get Out the Float are required to have a parent, legal guardian or designated chaperone accompanying at all times during the convention events and whilst on the premises.
- Minors Aged 17 and under are required to have a parent, legal guardian or designated chaperone be reachable and readily available whilst they attend Get Out the Float and associated events. This adult must be present within the city limits of Seaside, Oregon.
- The Minors age is defined as how old the minor will be whilst attending the event, from the first open day of the convention. Should the minor's birthday elapse during the event, this will not change the age requirements of said minor.

Legal Agreement

- You affirm that you are the minor's parent or legal guardian, and have the legal authority to enter this agreement regarding, and on behalf your minor child;
- You give permission and consent to your minor child to attend Get Out the Float for the time agreed to by their purchased membership;
- You agree that Get Out the Float LLC and all associated volunteers and staff, have no responsibility as to the supervision of the minor at any time during Get Out the Float.
- You agree to not hold; Get Out the Float LLC and all associated volunteers and staff, responsible for any wrongdoing, claims, demands, personal indemnity, loss or any liability;
- In the event of any damages caused by your minor child, at any time during Get Out the Float, you accept financial responsibility, and agree to fully indemnify and hold harmless Get Out the Float LLC for those damages;
- If the parent or legal guardian is unable to remain within the vicinity, they may designate another adult to take responsibility for the minor during their attendance. This designated adult must sign the below agreement in person at the event. *[See Page 3]*
